## Fearless Kit List

## Here is the kit list for Fearless. Don't post this back to us as you will need it! You can use it as a tick-sheet when packing.

O	1 holdall
0	1 sleeping bag
0	Personal toiletries
0	1 set of pyjamas
0	Personal medication (Epi-pens, asthma inhalers etc.)
0	Pocket money (in change please!) not exceeding £10
0	1 towel
0	Suncream and insect repellent
0	Large plastic bags (for soggy/muddy clothes)
0	4 T-shirts
0	3 pairs of loose fitting trousers (cotton jogging-bottoms are ideal)
0	1 thick pullover or fleece jacket
0	2 long-sleeved sweatshirts or hoodies
0	1 waterproof and windproof jacket
0	1 pair of waterproof trousers (if available)
0	5 pairs of walking socks
0	5 pairs of underwear
0	1 pair of old trainers (these are likely to get very muddy)
0	1 pair of indoors shoes/trainers (not slippers!
0	$1\ pair\ of\ wellington\ boots^{\star},\ or\ preferably\ waterproof\ walking\ boots\ with\ good\ ankle\ support$
0	1 warm hat and gloves
0	1 sunhat (eg. baseball cap)
0	1 torch

In addition to this kit, Young Leaders (those in Year 10 through Year 13) are asked to bring a Bible if they have one.

Parents should not feel obliged to purchase new clothing for *Fearless*. In fact, older clothes that are fine for getting muddy are ideal!

Items marked with an \* can be provided by BCYS if necessary, but are subject to availability as supplies are limited.

Participants may choose to bring a mobile phone to *Fearless* but we ask that they are turned off except in free time. There is also no facility to charge mobile phones. The group leader can always be contacted in case of emergency on **07462 915 810**. BCYS cannot accept responsibility for valuables or electonic devices such as mobile phones, tablets or iPods and participants bring them at their own risk. Participants are not allowed to use their own electrical appliances in Alton Castle (i.e. hairdryers, straighteners, etc.)

Participants will have to carry their own bags some distance upon arrival. Please make sure they are not too heavy!
