It includes four programmes of activity; Alton Castle which is the Residential Youth Retreat Centre for the Archdiocese serving young people aged 9-14 and Soli Centre for Youth Ministry for 14-to 18-year-olds. It includes a programme of youth work for 11-25-year-olds in parishes and chaplaincy support for schools across the Diocese.


Core residential work:
