Information Pack

A 2 week mission to Brazil for a lucky group of 25 young people from the Archdiocese of Birmingham.



GENERAL SCHEDULE

- a. 5 days in the week, you will spend the day at the mission centre (Meio da Serra), teaching English, visiting family homes, working on service projects in the community. Two of these mornings will be spent in the orphanage, teaching, playing games, singing songs, arts and crafts, sharing donations, learning about daily life
- b. During these days, time will also be scheduled for formation and aspects of Christian Life:
 - i. Our focus will be on growing in our understanding of Discipleship. We will also look to share ideas over Evangelisation today: Challenges in England and Brazil.

Getting to know CLMs ideas and our understanding of mission;
 - ii. Aspects of faith, personal and community prayer and spiritual life. Mass takes place every day, there is also the chance for adoration and night prayer together led by different team members.
- c. Community Dinner in the pastoral centre
- d. Brazilian culture sharing, fellowship, dance and visiting sites and attractions
- e.. Sundays
 - i CLM Community mass at Petrópolis, time with families, free time
 - ii Shared lunch: CLM pastoral centre/ Rosary and free time with CLM young people and community members.

One day a week will be a free day.

Day one : A visit to CHRIST THE REDEEMER! (There will be Mass in the chapel at the base of this iconic statue – A real moment of grace). This will be followed by an optional visit to SUGAR LOAF MOUNTAIN AND COPACABANA BEACH.

Day two: A trek through the national park to the beautiful isolated turtle beach.

MISSION WORK AT MISSION CENTRE (Meio da Serra):

- a. English Teaching (The English classes would be held in the school and solidarity centre)
- b. Service Projects: Cleaning, painting, gardening, improving life in the community
- c. House visiting: With an interpreter, taking the Word of God and having some prayer with the local community.
- d. Sharing with the children in the mission sports, arts and crafts, games and music etc.
- e. Health Care workshop: basic first aid, dental hygiene, baby care

PREPARATION WEEKEND (Feb 1st -3rd 2019)

There is one weekend residential in 2019. This is compulsory and will help you prepare for the Mission Encounter both practically and spiritually. It is also a great opportunity to build relationships and ask any questions.
